Dear Friends,

The new school year is ready to start in Burkina Faso. We have been preparing a secondary school for the children in the village of Kawara and surrounding areas.

The beginning of the school year is in view, however we were told that a fifth classroom and the administration building would be necessary for final approval from the government. Work on these buildings has begun in earnest.

**Our goal is to raise an additional \$38,000** to meet the needs of the additional buildings and start-up costs.

There is also an urgent need to replace our truck which has served us for 16 years. Recent inspection revealed worn and broken springs and motor supports which are difficult to purchase in Burkina. Our mechanic recommends replacing the vehicle. Replacing the truck will cost between **\$20,000 - \$26,000**. We have **\$7,000** in the bank designated for vehicle purchase.

**Join us in the challenge of raising these funds!**

I take this opportunity to thank you again for your prayers and interest in this ministry in Kawara, Burkina Faso. Together we can see the dreams in the Lord's heart become a source of blessing and mercy to people.
